

The Kind Bowl Project Volunteer Guide

A practical guide for safe, respectful, privacy-aware support in your own community.

1. Choose safe locations away from active traffic and conflict.
2. Bring appropriate dog food, clean bowls, fresh water, gloves, waste bags, and sanitizer.
3. Use clean bowls and remove food waste or packaging.
4. Do not approach aggressive, frightened, seriously injured, or unpredictable dogs.
5. Do not administer medicine or perform medical procedures.
6. Contact qualified local rescue or veterinary professionals for serious injury.
7. Respect residents, businesses, local laws, and public-health guidance.
8. Estimate unique dogs, food servings, water servings, and bowls placed or cleaned.
9. Do not publish exact feeding locations, geotags, GPS coordinates, or real-time routes.
10. Do not stage interactions for content. Safety and animal welfare come first.
11. Get consent before submitting identifiable people, especially children.
12. Submit only media you own or have permission to share.
